



**THE NAKED BROTHERS BAND  
PROMOTES ITS NICKELODEON SERIES AND SUMMER TOUR  
WITH A HANDPRINT CEREMONY AT  
PLANET HOLLYWOOD TIMES SQUARE  
THURSDAY, JUNE 4<sup>TH</sup> AT 4:00 PM**

**WHO:** **The Naked Brothers Band** - - consists of singer/composer/keyboardist **Nat Wolff** (age 14) and his 11-year-old brother **Alex Wolff** who serves as the bands drummer/singer/composer. First conceived in preschool, the band's title refers to when Nat and Alex were toddlers, they came out of the bathtub shouting, "We're the Naked Brothers Band!"

In addition to being band mates, Nat and Alex are also the stars of their own **Nickelodeon** series, ***The Naked Brothers Band***. Now in its third season, *The Naked Brothers Band* was created by Nat and Alex's real-life mom Polly Draper with music production by real-life dad Michael Wolff. **June 13<sup>th</sup> Nickelodeon airs *The Naked Brothers Band* summer episode "No School's Fools Day."**

**Nat Wolff** - - dubbed "the girl magnet," wrote 13 of the 15 songs from the television series that were featured on the debut Nickelodeon and Columbia Records album, ***The Naked Brothers Band***. On *The Naked Brothers Band's* second album ***I Don't Want To Go To School***, Nat wrote 11 of 14 songs. Multi-talented, Nat also wrote, directed and produced a short film entitled ***Don't Eat Off My Plate*** starring his parents.

**Alex Wolff** - - started playing the saxophone at age two but switched to drums a couple of years later. Not to be out-done by his older brother, Alex penned two of the songs, "I Could Be" and "Alien Clones" from their debut album, ***The Naked Brothers Band*** and three songs, "Why," "Three is Enough," and "Changing" from their second album, ***I Don't Want To Go To School***.

This summer Nat and Wolff embark on a multi-city summer tour and continue work on their upcoming third album.

**WHAT:** **The Naked Brothers Band** will be at **Planet Hollywood Times Square** for a handprint ceremony in the restaurant's main dining room.

*Their handprints will later be displayed on the walls of a TBD Planet Hollywood location.*
